# Frequently Asked Questions for Posters at AMCP 2021 Virtual

## 1. Am I required to upload my poster or a derivative of my content?

Posters will be uploaded by the Poster Abstracts Team. Send your final poster to posterabstracts@amcp.org by Monday, Mar. 29. Late submissions may not be uploaded in time for AMCP 2021 Virtual.

# 2. What are the size limitations for the poster, a derivative of the content, audio/video recording or headshot?

No larger than 10GB.

## 3. How should the poster be formatted?

Landscape formatting is preferred for best viewing; however, the system can accept posters in portrait formatting.

## 4. How do I upload my poster or headshot?

Posters and headshots will be uploaded by the Poster Abstracts Team.

## 5. What is the deadline by which final posters need to be submitted?

Final posters must be submitted to the Poster Abstracts Team at posterabstracts@amcp.org by Monday, Mar. 29

## 6. Is there an option to upload an audio/video recording?

Yes. Submit your audio/video recording to posterabstracts@amcp.org. The file cannot exceed larger than 10GB.

## 7. Do I need to register for AMCP 2021 Virtual?

Yes. The author(s) responding to attendee written chat questions during the open poster period on Tuesday, Apr. 13 and Wednesday, Apr. 14 from 1-2:30pm ET must register for AMCP 2021. The early bird registration deadline is March 16, and discounted rates are available for current students, residents, fellows and graduate student members.

## 8. What time do I need to be available to answer questions about my poster?

You need to be available on Tuesday, Apr. 13 and Wednesday, Apr. 14 from 1-2:30pm ET for a written chat with attendees who may have questions about your poster. Log-in instructions for registered poster presenter to follow.

# 9. Does the listed presenting author need to be the person available to answer questions?

No. Any author or non-author who is registered to attend AMCP 2021 Virtual can answer questions provided they have full knowledge of the content.

#### 10. How long are the posters available for registrants to view?

Registered attendees can view posters when the AMCP 2021 Virtual site opens on Mar. 18, 2021 through Dec. 31, 2021.

## 11. How long will the system be open for viewing posters post meeting?

The posters will be open to all (not just registered attendees) from Apr. 26 through Dec 31, 2021.

## 12. Do you accept QR codes (bar codes) on the posters?

Yes, QR codes are accepted as long as the code only connects to the abstract/poster and not a company website.

## 13. Does the presenting author's headshot need to be placed on the poster?

No, do not place the presenting author's headshot on the poster.

## 14. Will poster numbers be included on the posters?

No, do not include poster numbers on the posters being presented.

## 15. When will the abstract supplement appear online?

The abstract supplement will be available online two weeks prior to the presentation date.

## 15. Does AMCP have an embargo policy?

All abstracts accepted for presentation are embargoed from the time of submission until the Poster Abstract Supplement is posted to the JMCP Website (approximately two weeks before the AMCP meeting). The supplement can be found at www.jmcp.org/pages/MeetingAbstracts.

## 16. Whose name and email will be listed as point of contact in the JMCP Supplement?

The primary presenter's name and email will be listed as the point of contact.
